'கல்தோன்றி மண்தோன்றாக் காலத்தே வாளொடு முன்தோன்றிய மூத்தக்குடி தமிழ்குடி'. It is the art that convey such a proud Tamil tradition to the younger generations. Pastoral Art is an ancient art that is a feast for the eyes and the mind and it brings pleasure by capturing the hearts of the beholders. Tamil Nadu is the home of various arts such as Karakattam (கரகாட்டம்), Oyilatam (ஒயிலாட்டம்), Kummiyatam (கும்மியாட்டம்), Kaaliyattam (காளியாட்டம்), Puliyatam (புலியாட்டம்), Chilattam (சிலாட்டம்), Kolkal Attam (கோல்காலாட்டம்), Silambatam (சிலம்பாட்டம்). Such Pastoral arts are mixed in the blood and the flesh of the country people which expresses their minds, culture and tradition.

Paavai's Gramiya Kalai Vizha is an annual festival organized by the students of Paavai to revive those traditional arts of Tamil Nadu and proclaim that Paavaians have not forgotten their land goddesses, family deities and their roots. Different types of dances were performed by the students of all Paavai Institutions in Paavai's Gramiya Kalai Vizha 2022 with full zest and energy on 15.10.22.

Athanur Amman Song (அத்தனூர் அம்மன் பாடல்):

The deity who protects the clan is Kulatheivam. The belief that the ancestors who have become gods are the ones who protect us as eyes and thoughts is the reason for the worship of clan gods. Amman is often the goddess of the clan. The students of Paavai praised the supreme deityas a supreme mother who has risen up at Athanur in Kongunadu through their devotional dance.





Karakaattam (கரகாட்டம்):

Karakaattam is an art of holding a karakam on the head and stabilizing it. The word Karakam has many meanings like Kamandalam, Pookkudam, Kumbha, Sembu, Neerkudam. On the umbrella of Karakam there is a figure of a bird like parrot, swan or dove. It is the art where a karakam decorated in various ways is placed on the head to the tune of satirical mela music and danced such that the karakam does not fall down.


Kolkaalaattam (கோல்கால் ஆட்டம்):

A dance in which tall logs are tied to the legs like a crane with long legs is Kolkalatam. In ancient times, people used to tie wooden legs on their legs to easily carry out long distance journeys and to protect themselves from worms and insects while crossing the forest and mountains. Padhayatra is a pilgrimage to pray for the grace of Lord Murugaperumal, the king of Tamil. As the Murugan Pathayatra troupe, our Paavai students gave a feast to the eyes by dancing Kolkaalaattam.



Oyil Kummi (ஒயில் கும்மி):

Oyil Kummi is a dance played by beating the hand with a drum. It gets a special place in Pongal festival and temple festivals held in the Kongu villages where farmers live. Oyil Kummi is a game where group of people standing in a row or standing in a long line, dressed in colorful clothes, bend and twist according to various types of market. Our students of Paavai spreaded the beauty of dance through Oyil Kummi Aattam.



Maattu Kombu Saattai Kuchi Aattam is a village dance which symbolizes a game of chasing cows with cow horns and whip sticks in hand. It is related to the heroic game of Tamils called Jallikkattu, a game that extols the pride of Veerathamizan. Our Paavai students proved that they are also Veerathamizan through their performance.





Kaaliyaattam (காளியாட்டம்)

Kaaliyaattam is a faith-based traditional dance that takes place in Amman temple festivals. She stood entangled in her clothes and had garlands on bones and braided hair with ashes. Kaali who destroys the evils and protects us in the form of Trisulini Kalidevi has a multifaceted sword that has torn the body of evils to pieces on the battle field. Our Paavai boys expressed the stances of Kalidevi through the unbridled play of light.

Devaraattam (தேவராட்டம்):

A folk dance form performed in South India, a ritual of importance among the hunting community in Tamil Nadu. Devaraattam was performed in front and behind the chariot of the king to welcome the king after the victories in war. In those days, it was called Mun Thaer Kuruvai (புன் தேர் குறுவை) and Pinthaer Kuruvai (பின் தேர் குறுவை).Our Paavai warriors performed the dance with full vigor exposing the bravery and valor in war field.



Mallar Kambam (மல்லர் கம்பம்):

Mallar Kambam, is a heroic art of strengthening the body developed by the Cholas and Pallavas who ruled Tamil Nadu in ancient times. The early man carved the human figure in wood or stone and mounted it with a mallet to practice wrestling and hence the name Mallar Kambam. Mallar Kambam is a self-adventurous art that improves body flexibility and focuses the body and mind. Our heroes of Paavai showcased the art that grew up to overcome the fear of life.

Silambaattam (சிலம்பாட்டம்):

Silambaatam is the martial art of Tamils played with self-sacrifice for self-defence. History says that the silambam originated at the time when man took the pole in his hand to defend himself. It is also known as Kambuchuttuthal. Paavaians played with the silambam relaxed and happy made the audience spellbound.



Amman Aattam (அம்மன் ஆட்டம்)

In every town of Tamilnadu, Mariyamman fesitival is celebrated to calm Deviyamma who spontaneously lowers her attention to the devotees to get rid of their worries. Mariyamman festival as Amman Aattam in Paavai Gramiya Kalai Vizha, made the beholders to forget their qualms and elevated them to the state of peace and happiness.

A National Level Technical Symposium

TECHFINIX'22

Paavai Engineering College hosted a two day National Level Technical Symposium TECHFINIX'22 on 20.10.22 and 21.10.22 at Anandha Arangam. The inaugural session commenced with an invocation followed with Tamilthaivalthu. Smt.Mangai Natarajan, Correspondent, Paavai Institutions lighted the Kuthuvilaku along with the dignitaries.
