a) Regulations, course structure and syllabi of UG and PG and MCA programmes

The Principal informed the Governing Council that the first autonomous regulations are introduced in 2015-16 in tune with the outcome based education policies to meet the global challenges as enforced by the accreditation authorities. He also informed that the process had been completed and the revised content was presented to Academic Council and got its approval. Further, he requested the Governing Council to give its consent for implementation.

Similarly each practical course (including project work & viva voce Examinations) shall be evaluated for a maximum of 100 marks with **50 marks** as Internal Marks based on the Continuous Internal Assessment and **50 marks** as External Marks based on the End Semester Examinations.

7. To construct a new laboratory for Agriculture, Aeronautical and Chemical Engineering Departments.
8. To accelerate the Placement and Training cell to bring MNCs for campus placement.
9. To continue the subscription of IEEE journals.

10. To make the Faculty and Students to effectively utilize the Microsoft Innovation Centre Wipro Mission 10X Learning Centre and TVS Haritha Techserve.
