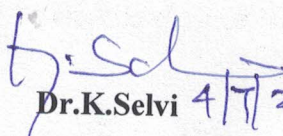
Points suggested by the Academic Council Members

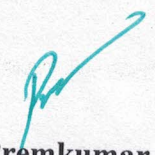


Grading systems may be implemented from the 2025–2026 batch onwards.
