

MINUTES

The Committee Chairman welcomed the members and briefed them on the agenda items. The committee members actively participated in detailed discussions and exchanged valuable suggestions. After deliberation, the following resolutions were made:

- The schedules for the Faculty Revalidation Programme (FRP), *Invigorate '26*, Graduation Day, *Astra* Cultural Fest, Annual Day, and Sports Day were discussed and initiated for finalization.
- Plans were proposed for visits to Taiwan and other foreign countries to renew existing Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) and to establish new MoUs with foreign universities, aiming to enhance international exposure for students.
- All departments were advised to incorporate Artificial Intelligence and other relevant modern technologies into their curricula. To provide exposure to advanced technologies, several on-campus programmes with eminent experts were planned for faculty members and students.
- Faculty members were encouraged and guided to enhance their research output in terms of research publications, patents, grants, book chapters, funded projects, consultancy work, and organizing international conferences. Their progress will be periodically reviewed.
- Training strategies were discussed and finalized to upskill students and improve placement opportunities with better packages.
- Measures for strengthening industry collaboration were discussed and finalized, including student projects, faculty consultancy work, and the establishment of industry-sponsored laboratories within the institution.
